"14 But whosoever drinketh of

the **Water** that I shall give him shall never athirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life (John 4:14)

"2 As anewborn babes, desire

the <u>bsincere</u> <u>cmik</u> of the word, that ye may grow thereby:" (1 Peter 2:2)

"2 I have fed you with milk, and not

with **meat**: for hitherto ye were not able *to bear it,* neither yet now are ye able" (1 Corinthians 3:2).

## **"15** Butter

and **honey** shall he eat, that he may know to refuse the evil and to choose the good" (2 Nephi 17:15).

"18 And I hold forth and deign to give unto you greater riches, even a land of <u>promise</u>, a land <u>flowing</u> with milk and

"2 Keep my <u>commandments</u>, and live; and my law as

the **apple** of thine eye" (Proverbs 7:2).

"11 A <u>word</u> fitly spoken is

like apples of gold in pictures of silver" (Proverbs 25:11).

"44 For every tree is known by his own <u>afruit</u>. For of thorns men do not gather figs, nor of a bramble bush gather they

grapes" (Luke 6:44).

"16 Ye shall <u>aknow</u> them by their <u>bfruits</u>. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or **figs** of thistles?" (Matthew 7:16).

"13 ¶ Ye are the asalt of the earth:

but if the **Salt** have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be **salted?** it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men" (Matthew 12:13).

"12 Can the fig tree, my brethren,

bear **Olive** berries?

either a vine, figs? so *can* no fountain both yield salt water and fresh" (James 3:12).

"5 We remember the fish, which we did eat in Egypt freely; the

cucumbers, and the melons, and the leeks,

and the **ONIONS**, and the

qarlick:" (Numbers 11:5).

"11 If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if *he ask* a

**fish**, will he for a fish give him a serpent?

12 Or if he shall ask an **egg**, will he offer him a scorpion?" (Luke 11:11-12).

"3 \*Angels speak by the power of the Holy Ghost; wherefore, they speak the words of Christ. Wherefore, I said unto you, bfeast upon the words of Christ; for behold, the words of Christ will tell you all things what ye should do" (2 Nephi 32:3).
