

Scripture References for “Feast Upon the Words of Christ” Singing Time

“35 And Jesus said unto them, I am the **bread** of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never **thirst**” (John 6:35).

“14 But whosoever drinketh of the **water** that I shall give him shall never **thirst**; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water **springing up** into **everlasting life**” (John 4:14)

“2 As **newborn** babes, desire the **sincere milk** of the word, that ye may grow thereby:” (1 Peter 2:2)

“2 I have fed you with **milk**, and not with **meat**: for hitherto ye were not able *to bear it*, neither yet now are ye able” (1 Corinthians 3:2).

“15 **Butter** and **honey** shall he eat, that he may know to refuse the evil and to choose the good” (2 Nephi 17:15).

“18 And I hold forth and deign to give unto you greater riches, even a land of **promise**, a land **flowing** with milk and **honey**, upon which there shall be no **curse** when the Lord cometh;” (Doctrine and Covenants 38:18).

“13 ¶ Ye are the <sup>a</sup>salt of the earth:

but if the **salt** have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be **salted**? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men” (Matthew 12:13).

“12 Can the fig tree, my brethren,

bear **olive** berries?  
either a vine, figs? so *can* no fountain both yield salt water and fresh” (James 3:12).

“5 We remember the fish, which we did eat in Egypt freely; the

**cucumbers**, and the **melons**, and the leeks,

and the **onions**, and the

**garlick**.” (Numbers 11:5).

“11 If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if *he ask* a

**fish**, will he for a fish give him a serpent?

12 Or if he shall ask an **egg**, will he offer him a scorpion?” (Luke 11:11-12).
