Fruit Game Ideas

• Apple Tree, Apple Tree

- 1) Sing the song.
- 2) When the song stops, pick a seed.
- 3) Read the action on the back.
- 4) Tell what "fruit of the Spirit" it would grow into.

• Fruity Flavors

- 1) Taste the Fruit Loop (or fruit snack).
- 2) Guess the flavor of the fruit.
- 3) If you get it right, you choose the next person.
- 4) If you get it wrong, you answer a question.

• Fruit Salad

- 1) Sing the song.
- 2) Helper throws beanbags at fruit pictures.
- 3) When the song ends, read the scripture on the back of the fruits.
- 4) Those fruits go into the "fruit salad" of our testimony.

Go Bananas Game

- 1) Sing the song with me.
- 2) I'm going to sneak the word "banana" into the song.
- 3) When you hear "banana," do this [act like a monkey].
- 4) When you see the banana, go back to singing.

• Grape Relays

- 1) Get a spoon from your teacher.
- 2) Sing the song with me.
- 3) Pass the grape down your row using only your spoons.
- Before the song ends, get the grape to the end of your "vine" (i.e., row).

• Grape Smash

- 1) Sing the song.
- 2) Roll the grape into your partner's Ziploc bag.
- 3) Your partner rolls the grape back to you.
- 4) Zip the bags at the end of the song.
- 5) You get to smash the grapes in your bag.

Fruit Game Ideas

• Harvest Relays

- 1) Line up with your class here.
- 2) Take turns running to the tree and picking a fruit.
- 3) Run the fruit to the fruit basket.
- 4) Give the spoon/tongs to a new person.
- 5) Before the song ends, try to harvest all the fruit.
- **Hi Ho Cherry-o** (Commercial board game)
 - 1) Spin the spinner.
 - 2) Read the number out loud.
 - 3) We will sing the song that many times.
 - 4) Put a cherry on the tree (or take one off) each time we sing.
 - 5) Your goal is to get as much fruit as possible.

• I Heard it Through the Grapevine

- 1) Listen as your teacher whispers part of the song to you.
- 2) Whisper it to the next person in your class.
- 3) Keep doing it until the end.
- 4) When we sing the song, your class only sings their line.
- Musical Fruits (can also do with balloons made to look like fruit)
 - 1) Your class will come to the front.
 - 2) Sing as you walk in a circle (like musical chairs).
 - 3) When the music stops, grab a play fruit from the middle of the circle.
 - 4) If you don't have a fruit, sit down.

• Orange Juice Squeeze

- 1) Primary sings the song.
- 2) Primary twists back and forth to make OJ.
- 3) Helper roll oranges into buckets before end of song.
- 4) If helper succeeds, they get a drink of OJ.

• Please Pass the Peaches!

- 1) Sing the song with me.
- 2) Pass the fake peach while we sing.
- 3) Try to get the peach to the front of the room before the song ends.

Fruit Game Ideas

• Strawberry Surprise

- 1) Sing the song with me.
- 2) I will hide a strawberry under a cup.
- 3) When the song ends, try to guess which cup it's under.

• Think, PEAR, Share

- 1) Think: Look at the fruit pictures.
- 2) Pair: Whisper your favorite fruit into your hand.
- 3) Share: Tell your partner your answer.

Upset the Fruit Basket

- 1) Sing the song with me.
- 2) If I sing a fruit, shift one seat to the right. (or trade places with a friend if I say your fruit)

• Watermelon, Watermelon

- 1) Sing the song.
- 2) I will give super singers a sticker.
- 3) Get as many seeds on the watermelon as you can before the song ends.

Possible fruit props:

- Fruit balloons
- Fruit bags (made to look like fruits)
- Fruit-flavored cereal (i.e., Fruit Loops or Fruity Pebbles)
- Fruit plates (that look like fruits—you can buy them at the party store)
- Fruit snacks (or real fruit or fruit salad for grown-ups)
- Fruit stickers
- Plastic play fruit
