Introduction

ASK: What does the scripture mean that says we should not give "grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver" (2 Corinthians 9:7)? (Target answer: We should give things because we want to, not because we have to)

ASK: What does it mean to be cheerful? (Target answer: Happy, hopeful, and optimistic)

SAY: We're going to play *Minute to Win It* to learn about things we can give even when we don't have a lot of time or money. Choose a smile to find out which game we'll play.
