Most of us won't qualify for perdition (an issue of accountability—God, in His mercy, doesn't reveal more than we can be responsible for)

Jesus Christ has the knowledge, power, and ability to save us all, but we also have to do our part.

We have to do our part additional details of the general plan (and of Heavenly Father's plan for our individual lives) are revealed to us as we try to draw closer to Him

Temporal acts have spiritual consequences

Death = separation of body and spirit

Hell = separation from God

He is the source of all happiness—as we draw closer to Him, we become happier

Alma 12:30-33:

30 And they began from that time forth to call on his name; therefore God <sup>a</sup>conversed with men, and made known unto them the <sup>b</sup>plan of redemption, which had been prepared from the <sup>c</sup>foundation of the world; and this he made known unto them according to their faith and repentance and their <sup>d</sup>holy works.
